Summary of the FLMWC Plumbing Fixture Retrofit Policy

All residential buildings receiving water from the FLMWC are required to be retrofitted completely, if not already conforming, with high efficiency plumbing fixtures at the time of sale of the property. Under the policy, the **seller of the property** is responsible for the following:

- 1. Replacing any toilets and showerheads that don't meet the water consumption standards,
- 2. Arranging for a verification inspection, and
- 3. Obtaining a Water Conservation Certificate from the FLMWC

A copy of the Water Conservation Certificate is to be included with documents transferring title to the property.

Water Consumption Plumbing Standards

Plumbing fixtures must be manufactured to meet the flush volume and flow rate standards listed below, or less. Flow restrictors and other modifications to fixtures are not acceptable.

Toilets 1.28 gallons per flush Showerheads
Showerheads 2.0 gallons per minute
Existing 1.6 gallon per flush toilets on the property do not need to be retrofitted and are considered to meet the requirements under the code.

Instructions

Step 1 - Retrofit: Make sure that all fixtures on the property you are selling meet the plumbing standards listed above, and replace any that do not. If you are unsure how much water your toilet flushes, see the information sheet *How Much Water Does Your Toilet Use?*, available at the FLMWC Office and company web site: www.forestlakesfelton.com

Step 2 - Inspection: Complete this form and contact the FLMWC Office to arrange for a free inspection. You may choose to hire a licensed plumbing or general building contractor to perform the inspection, if you prefer. If so, the contractor will need to complete Part 3 on the front of this form. Contractors may not inspect their own property.

Step 3 - Certification: The FLMWC Office will sign the certificate at the time of inspection. If you choose to have the property inspected by a licensed plumbing or building contractor, bring in or mail the completed form to:

When received at the office, the certificate will be signed and returned to you. Please note that the FLWMC Office cannot accept certificates with missing signatures or incomplete information.

Option to Have Buyer Retrofit

The responsibility for retrofitting may be transferred from the seller to the buyer, if both parties mutually agree to do so. If the buyer of your property prefers to complete the retrofit, call the FLMWC Office for a **Transfer of Responsibility to Retrofit Form.** The seller must file the signed form with the FLMWC Office, in lieu of this certificate, before the property is sold.

Failure to Retrofit

You will be liable to the buyer for \$250 for each fixture that does not comply, or for the actual cost to the buyer to comply, whichever is greater, if you fail to complete the retrofit.
